### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

I have decided to pen this message, as this is probably the last printed version of the HWA Digest that you will be receiving. There are two reasons why we decided to stop the printed version of HWA Digest; reasons which we highlighted during our Annual General Meeting (AGM) 2018.

We are slowly moving towards communicating with you through electronic media instead of paper circulars so we can be more environmentally friendly. E-communications not only make information more accessible, as you can access them at your convenience, it allows information to reach you faster. We are seriously considering alternative media to reach to our members.
